The group will utilise the BS EN ISO Standards to fulfil this obligation, ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management Systems, ISO 45001:2018 Occupational Health & Safety Management System and ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management System

Unitech Industries will pursue improvements in environmental performance, especially in the reduction of solid, liquid and gaseous emissions and waste. Reduce energy consumption, recycling and improved waste disposal methods will be encouraged.

Legal requirements will be set as a minimum.

Unitech Industries is committed to supporting this Policy and to maintaining effective systems of communication on environmental requirements inside and outside of the company.

It shall be the responsibility of the management and supervision:-

- To observe the principles and provisions incorporated in the relevant legislation and standards to ensure safe systems of work incorporating environmental protection.
- By consultation and joint involvement of managers and employees, to enlist active interest, support and participation in promoting good standards of environmental performance.
- To ensure that all concerned are fully aware through instruction, training and supervision of their own personal responsibility for environmental performance.

It shall be the responsibility of every Unitech employee: -

- To take reasonable care for the environment and to report any hazard which cannot be controlled personally.
- To co-operate with the company by observing rules and complying with any measures designed to ensure environmental protection.

Operation Directors and Works Managers have overall responsibility for environmental performance on Company Sites and will be supported by the Financial Director and Group Health & Safety Manager (GHSM). Departmental Managers will have responsibility for their own specific areas
